CLEANING DENTURES

- 1. Dentures should be removed at night and placed in water while you sleep.
- 2. Place dentures in a denture cleansing solution overnight, or at least 30 minutes daily.
- 3. Before soaking lightly brush dentures with a soft toothbrush. Do not use toothpaste to clean your denture; it will abrade your denture making it more susceptible to carry fungal infections. After soaking, thoroughly remove all cleanser by light brushing under tap water
- 4. To prevent breaking dentures, brush denture over a towel or over a basin half-filled with water.
- 5. Massage gums daily with a thumb, finger, or soft toothbrush for five minutes in the morning and five minutes in the evening.
